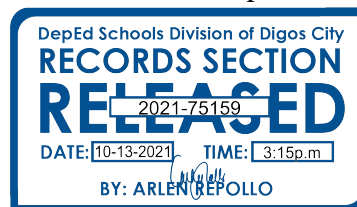

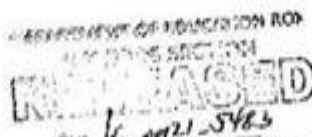

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

Despite the prolonged lockdown due to the current state of COVID-19 pandemic in the country, the Department of Education (DepEd) continues to uphold its commitment to provide relevant and quality education to all learners, especially when it comes to developing foundational skills such as literacy and numeracy in the early grades.

In this regard, the Bureau of Learning Delivery – Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD), together with the Research Triangle Institute (RTI) International and the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER), will be conducting a **Formative Assessment Training for K-3 on 6-10 September 2021** via Zoom.

The 5-day blended learning course is focused on the design and use of formative assessment to improve literacy and numeracy outcomes in K-3 classrooms. The emphasis will be on informal, classroom-based assessment strategies that are embedded within daily teaching and learning experiences. In this training, the participants will:

- Strengthen their understanding of formative assessment, including the purpose of formative, strategies for formative assessment in K-3 lessons, and using information gained from formative assessment to provide feedback and make decisions for future teaching and learning;
- Apply their understanding to develop an activity that will be used to formatively assess students' literacy and numeracy development in their classroom. This will include links to the curriculum, plans for eliciting evidence of what students know and can do, and plans for how the evidence will be interpreted and used;

- Practice interpreting and reflecting on evidence gathered from classroom-based formative assessment through the use of classroom scenarios and student work samples;
 - Practice using evidence to provide useful feedback to students on their learning;
 - Build a repertoire of formative assessment strategies that can be used in literacy and mathematics lessons; and
 - Strengthen their understanding of the role of the student in formative assessment and the strategies that support students to actively contribute to the process of formative assessment.
