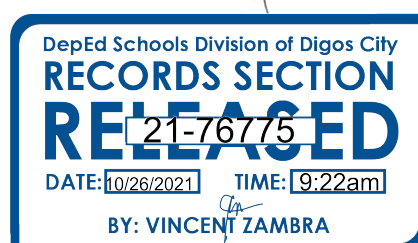
KINDERGARTEN VIRTUAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No 10661 titled “An Act Declaring the Month of November as Children’s Month, the Regional Office informs the field of the conduct of the Children’s Culmination Activity thru showcasing of talents among Kindergarten Learners.
2. In line with this, the Kindergarten Department of Digos City Division will conduct the “Kindergarten Virtual Festival of Talents” on November 16, 2021 with the theme “New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan“. This activity aims to showcase the rights and talents of Kindergarten Learners as they are learning in this new normal of which a safety and health protocols must be strictly observed.
3. The kindergarten winners at the Division will compete to the Regional Children’s Month Culminating Contest which will be on November 29, 2021. Before the contest, video of the contestant will be submitted on November 22, 2021 to Regional Office for Pre-Judging.

Subject: CHILDREN'S MONTH CELEBRATION

Date : October 15, 2021

The Department of Education – Regional Office XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) joins the Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), other government agencies, and the whole nation in celebrating the 2021 National Children's Month (NCM), with the theme, "New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata Atang Tutukan!", this November 2021.

The celebration is pursuant to Republic Act No. 10661, titled *An Act Declaring the Month of November of Every Year as the National Children's Month*, which honors the ratification of the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) by the United Nations General Assembly on November 20, 19889, and further articulates the importance of the CRC to the Filipino consciousness. It mandates DepEd to facilitate and to encourage the celebration of the NCM in all public and private schools nationwide.

In this note, this Office informs the field of the conduct of the Children's Month Culmination Activity on November 29-30, 2021. The activity showcases the rights and talents of the Kindergarten learners as they are learning in this new normal (please see attached files) of which safety and health protocols must be strictly observed.

Expenses incurred by the schools/participants relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against the local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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II. Vlog

1. The contest is open to all public schools only. Each Division must have one (1) official entry.
2. All submitted recorded entries should be original work and must not be less than three (3) minutes or more than five (5) minutes in duration.
3. There will be three participants per entry (division) to cover the content story.
4. Language to be used is Binisaya.
5. The contestants must appear on the vlog for the entry to be considered.
6. Each entry must focus on the theme: “New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata ating Tutuka!”.
7. The video must possess the following specifications.
 - a. The vlog entries should be in landscape orientation and in the highest quality possible.
 - b. Entries must be in MP4 format and uploaded on the goggle drive link.
 - c. Intellectual copyright or intellectual property must always be observed.
 - d. It should be value-laden. Using profane, obscene, abusive language and behavior is strictly prohibited.
 - e. The judges have the right to disqualify and to eliminate contestants if they violate any of the guidelines and rules.
 - f. All entries must begin with a 5-second full-screen title page that follows the format below:
Name of Contestants
School Name
Title of the video
Total runtime

8. Submission of entries will be on November 22, 2021.



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Criteria for Judging (Vlog)

The decision of the panel of judges based on the following criteria is final and irrevocable.

Criteria	Description	Percentage
Originality and Creativity	This is the overall concept and story line. Participants must be able to show creativity in delivering the message of the vlog and the theme.	35%
Content - 35%	This is the overall script. The participants should be able to show relevance to the theme.	35%
Editing and Technical Quality	This is how the video is edited. Sequencing, background music, sound effects, and cut-to-cut editing style.	30%

MECHANICS AND CRITERIA

I. DRAW AND TELL

1. The contest is open to all public schools only. Each Division must have one (1) official entry.
2. Each contestant must provide his/her own prescribe drawing materials (Oslo paper, pencil, and crayons (8 colors)).
3. The drawing should be value-laden with relevance to the theme: *"New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata ating Tutukan!"*.
4. Contestants are given 30 minutes to finish their drawing. Note: This will be recorded with audio from the start to finish.
5. There will be no lettering and boarders to be added.
6. The contestants will present and tell the story about their drawing. Time limit for the telling phase is a minimum of one (1) minute and a maximum of three (3)-minute presentation. Note: This will be recorded with audio from the start to finish.
7. Language to be used is Binisaya.
8. Criteria for judging:

A. Relevance to the Theme	- 20%
B. Oral Presentation	-30%
C. Technical Aspect	- 10%
D. Visual Impact and Creativity	-25%
E. Originality	-15%
