

REQUEST FOR DATA ON CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEES IN SCHOOLS

- To: SGOD and CID Chiefs Public Schools District Supervisors Division Youth Formation Coordinators School Heads of all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
- 1. Pursuant to Unnumbered Regional Memorandum and Unnumbered Memorandum from the Office of Undersecretary, Atty. Revsee A. Escobedo, entitled "Request for Data on Child Protection Committees in Schools", this Office directs all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools to establish a Child Protection Committee, which shall be composed of the following, viz:
 - 1. School Head/Administrator Chairperson;
 - 2. Guidance Counselor/Teacher Vice-Chairperson;
 - 3. Representative of the Teachers as designated by the Faculty Club;
 - 4. Representative of the Parents as designated by the Parents-Teachers Association;
 - 5. Representative of pupils, students and learners as designated by the Supreme Student Council/Government; and
 - 6. Representative from the Community as deignated by the Punong Barangay, preferably a member of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC).
- 2. In view of the foregoing, schools are requested to submit a list of the members of the Child Protection Committees in Schools and accomplish the CPC Training Needs Survey (Enclosure) through the Google link: https://tinyurl.com/CPCTrainingNeedsSurvey.
- 3. Kindly submit the said survey form on or before January 31, 2022 using the template in the enclosed Regional Memorandum through the link above and to the Regional Child Protection Focal, Stephen Mark T.
