INTERIM GUIDELINES ON THE EXPANSION OF LIMITED FACE TO FACE CLASSES

- 1. Attached is the Unnumbered Regional Memorandum, pursuant to Office Order OO-OSEC-2022-003 dated 2 February 2022 from the Office of Secretary Leonor Matolis Briones. The following interim guidelines are hereby set for the continued progressive expansion of the limited face-to-face classes in both private and public schools:
 - a. Expansion schools have been validated as compliant with the standard of School Safety Assessment Tool (SSAT);
 - b. Schools must be in areas under Alert Levels 1 and 2 based on the periodic assessment by the Department of Health (DOH);
 - c. Schools may already include other grade levels based on the capacity of schools;
 - d. Schools or divisions must have secured the concurrence of the Local Chief Executive in the City or Municipality where the expansion school is located, and the schools must also have taken the proper coordination with their respective barangay officials;
 - e. Students participating in the face-to-face classes must have the written consent of their parents;
 - f. Schools are given flexibility in contact time for teaching and learning, provided that meals are not taken in school except during managed recess; and
 - g. Only vaccinated teachers may participate and vaccinated learners shall be preferred.
- 2. The main protocols and standards in the DepEd-DOH Joint Memorandum Circular 001, s. 2021 shall remain applicable as appropriate, until a Revised Joint Memorandum along with the DepEd Implementation Guidelines are issued, containing the details of the implementation of the expansion phase.



- Schools or division must have secured the concurrence of the Local Chief Executive in the City or municipality where the expansion school is located, and the schools must have taken the proper coordination with their respective barangay officials;
- 5. Students participating in the face-to-face classes must have the written consent of their parents:
- Schools are given flexibility in contact time for teaching and learning, provided that meals are not taken in school except during managed recess; and
- 7. Only vaccinated teachers may participate, and vaccinated learners shall be preferred.
