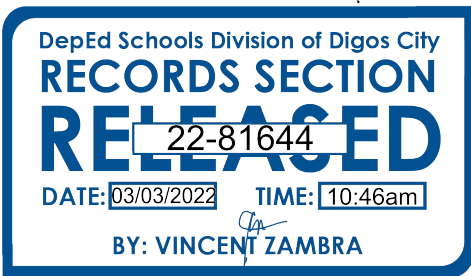

Greetings!


