DIRECTIVE TO SERVE AS MEDICAL / FIRST AID RESPONDERS ON MAY 9, 2022 NATIONAL AND LOCAL ELECTIONS

To: Health and Nutrition Unit Division DRRM Coordinator Schools' DRRM Focal Persons Schools' Clinic Coordinator

- 1. This has reference to the communication from the Office of the City Election Officer, Commission on Election, re: Request for the Department of Education's School Nurses in schools assigned as voting centers to report for duty on May 9, 2022, in response to the request raised by Mr. Samuel Miralles, Head of the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC) in the meeting conducted last May 2, 2022, on the lack of medical/first aid responders during the Election Day.
- 2. In view hereof, the undersigned hereby directs all nurses, schools' DRRM focal persons and schools' clinic coordinators identified in *Enclosure 1*, to report for duty on May 9, 2022, to function as Medical/First Aid Responders.
- 3. Dr. Jasmine A. Asarak, the Health and Nutrition Unit Head, and Mr. Jayzon T. Cardines, the DRRM Coordinator, are likewise instructed to coordinate as far as the arrangement is concerned and to monitor reports from the field regarding health and safety concerns which shall be forwarded to Division Election Task Force for consolidation and appropriate action.
- 4. Service Credits shall be granted, per DepEd Memorandum 208, s. 2004 or the Grant of Service Credits for Election Duties, pursuant to DepEd Order 53, s. 2003. Completely filled-out Daily Time Record or CSC Form 48, and the copy of the signed issuance shall be attached as documentary requirements to be submitted to the Division Human Resource Management Office.
