RE: REQUEST OF DIVISION FEDERATED BARKADA KONTRA DROGA TO CONDUCT COASTAL CLEAN-UP DRIVE AT BARANGAY APLAYA, DIGOS CITY

DATE: JUNE 11, 2022 (SATURDAY); 5:30 AM TO 8:00 AM

FACTS:

- In reference to Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases re: Guidelines on the Nationwide Implementation of Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response" dated February 27, 2022, Section 5, Paragraph 3, For Alert Level 2, the following establishments, or activities, shall be allowed to operate, or be undertaken at a maximum of 50% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals only and 70% outdoor venue capacity. Provided that all organizers of activities are fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Digos City is placed under Alert Level 2.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Proper coordination with the officials of Barangay Aplaya, Digos City.
- Secure permit in Barangay Aplaya, Digos City
- · Vaccination status of the participants shall be checked.
- Health declaration form must be available and submit to the organizer.
- During the activity, social/physical distancing shall be observed as well as the
 wearing of face masks, checking of body temperature, and sanitizing or washing
 their hands.
