







- The activity can be done through virtual platform.



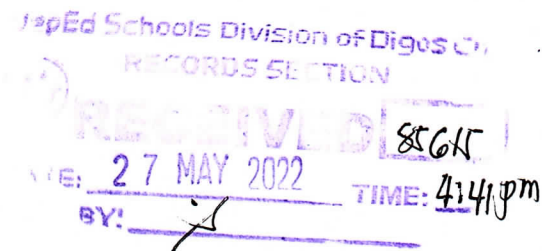
