
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

Republic Act No. 11315 otherwise known as Community-Based Monitoring System Act (CBMS Act) was enacted on April 17, 2019, institutionalizing the conduct of the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) in every city and municipality in the country. The CBMS is an organized technology-based system of collecting, processing, and validating necessary disaggregated data that may be utilized for planning, program implementation, and impact monitoring at the local level while empowering communities to participate in the process.

Furthermore, CBMS Council Resolution No. 6, series of 2021 encouraged city and municipal government units to establish a City/Municipal Coordinating Board to monitor and ensure smooth flow of CBMS operations in their jurisdiction.

In this regard, the city government of Digos through the Office of the City Planning and Development Coordinator (OCPDC) is drafting an Executive Order to establish the City's CBMS Coordinating Board. Relative thereto, your office is required to provide the name of the agency's permanent representative using the nomination form attached.
