2022 SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL SUMMIT CUM CAREER GUIDANCE

To : All Schools Division Superintendents

1. One of the goals of the K to 12 Basic Education Program is to develop in learners the competencies, work ethics, and values relevant to pursuing further education and/ or joining the world of work. In pursuance to Republic Act 10533 or the Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013, the Department of Education Regional Office XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the **"2022 Senior High School Summit Cum Career Guidance"** as part of the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) and in response to the challenges of the delivery of basic education in the new normal for SY 2021-2022 on **July 27- 28, 2022** at Tagum City Atrium, New City Hall, Ayala Avenue, Tagum City.
2. This is a showcase of outputs/products and recorded skills performances of the learners in the different schools in 11 SDOs of Region XI as evidence of the knowledge and skills learned by the SHS learners in all tracks and strands from online classes, Self-Learning Modules (SLMs), performance activities and skills development trainings for SY 2021-2022 despite the threat of covid19 pandemic.
3. SDOs are advised to set-up the booth/area assigned to them on July 26, 2022 showcasing the best outputs of the learners in all learning areas. Hence, all SDO Learning Area Supervisors are advised to handle necessary arrangements in enhancing the Division's booth.
4. The activity is not a competition, but rather a confirmation of alignment and compliance on the standards set per competency as stipulated in the Curriculum Guides per learning area; DO 021, s.2019 - Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program; and DO 73, s. 2012 - Guidelines on the Assessment and Rating of Learning Outcomes Under the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum.
5. There will be resource speakers to discuss topics that would eventually help in guiding the Grade 10 completers and Grade 12 learners on the future career that they can pursue.
6. Grade 10 to 12 learners together with their parents are be invited to join the



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SHS Summit through face to face or via FB-live for them to be aware of what the learners did and how they learned during the new normal and for career guidance and information.

7. Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, CLMD Chief, CLMD EPSs, CID Chiefs, SGOD Chiefs, SHS Focal Persons, SHS School Heads, SDO EPSs, Guidance Counselors, and SHS Teachers are enjoined to attend the activity.


