Global citizenship: Starting from a classroom, reaching out to a community

APCEIU is committed to enhancing the capacities of educators on fostering global citizenship through education, and as part of its efforts of supporting educators, training programmes in various forms have been offered to key educators around the world. With the accumulated experiences and expertise in the area of teacher training on global citizenship. APCEIU has contributed to helping educators to become active agents of change coping with the challenges they face in the rapidly changing learning environment.

Change can start with the educators in the classroom. As global citizens themselves, teachers can transform the classroom a place for dialogue and participation.
