Pursuant to the Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 34 Series of 2022 titled "**School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023**" the Supreme Government Pupil (SPG) and Supreme Student Government (SSG) Elections are scheduled on the first to second week of September. Stated on the same issuance, it is imperative to monitor the compliance of schools with the mechanisms and standards of the policy, including the conduct and implementation of activities indicated in the School Calendar.

As part of the continuous improvement of the programs implemented by DepEd, the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns - Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD) will conduct the **EduAksyon : SPG and SSG Elections Field Monitoring and Evaluation** on **September 12-16, 2022**.

In line with this, it is informed that the identified schools shall be monitored and evaluated on their scheduled date/s. It is also informed that the assigned Project Development Officers (PDOs) I / Division Youth Formation Coordinators shall join during the monitoring in their respective Divisions.

Travelling and other incidental expenses to be incurred during this monitoring and evaluation shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
