**REITERATION OF THE COMPLIANCE WITH WATER IN SCHOOLS (WINS) IN THE LIGHT OF THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC**


To : All Public Schools District Supervisors  
 All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
 All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to DO No. 10, s. 2016, otherwise known as **“POLICY AND GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE IN SCHOOLS (WINS) PROGRAM”** dated February 19, 2016 on the promotion of correct hygiene and sanitation practices among school children and a clean environment in and around schools to keep learners safe and healthy, this Office, reiterates compliance by the schools with the five-Policy objectives, accentuating on policy no. 2, among others, which reads as follows: **improve equitable access to safe water, adequate toilets, and hand washing facilities.**
2. Relevant to this, in observance to the minimum public health standards (MPHS) as required under DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2022 on Health and Safety Protocols in Light of Covid 19 Pandemic, all schools shall ensure the availability of handwashing facilities, where a group of handwashing facility should have at least ten (10) water outlets as one (1) handwashing facility in elementary and four (4) water outlets as 1 handwashing facility in the secondary level. Given the current data the standard ratio is (1) group handwashing facility for every 100 students.
3. All schools that do not have group handwashing facility to date, are required to provide at least one (1), with the advice that the schools engage public and private partners for program implementation and sustainability (DO 10, s. 2016 policy no. 5) as per DepEd design, utilizing partnership and linkages.
4. Attached is the list of schools with and without group handwashing facility.
5. The Schools Division Office, through Health and Nutrition Unit and SGOD shall monitor and provide technical assistance in the overall implementation of Wash in Schools (WINS) to determine its efficiency and effectiveness as well as problem areas.
