- b. Filipino for the subjects in Filipino, Araling Panlipunan, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, and MAPEH Grades 1-3.
- c. The use of Mother Tongue as the language of instruction beginning in Grade I is now recognized as the most effective way to improve student learning and shall also serve as a strong bridge language to learn a second language better and faster.

d. For learners in the Alternative Learning System, the Mother Tongue is likewise recommended as the language of instruction for basic literacy.
