

In line with the Department's continued thrust to promote E-Saliksik (Edukasyon Saliksik), which was adopted through DepEd Order 14 s. 2022 and launched on 14 March 2022 as the central repository of education research, we would like to announce that we are further expanding access to the portal, to an hade all grantees of Basic Education Research Fund from FY 2015 to present. This will enable access to completed researches relevant to their work stations and help promote use of evidence and sharing of knowledge through the researches uploaded in the portal. As of date, 147 BERF funded researches and 20 Research Bulletins can be accessed through the portal and 3,209 subscriber accounts had been created for end users.

As part of a phased implementation to provide access to the portal, Policy Planning and Research Division (PPRD) are requested to lead the registration of all BERF grantees by disserninating the account request form at the link bit.ly esaliksiksignups02.
