Dear Director Farnazo:

The Department is set to register and serve a total of 4.4 million Pantawid Pamilya households, of which Field Office XI has a target share of 284,166 households for CY 2023.

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As of 30 November 2022, the Field Office XI already covers a total of **262,440** households (250,090 are from RCCT and 12,350 are from MCCT) or 92.35% of the 2023 annual physical target (284,166) are registered and still active in the program. Given this, the program still needs to cover a total of **21,726** households to complete the target annual share. However, there are **about 20,000 households that are already validated and recommended for delisting** upon actual validation of the identified first batch of Listahanan 3 (L3) Non-Poor households by the National Household Targeting Office (NHTO). Therefore, **about 23,000 households need to be registered as replacement households to complete the program's physical target**.

Further, this number may change due to the dynamic nature of the client status management which involves deactivation/delisting and the reactivation of households and the ongoing validation and assessment of unassessed and second batch of non-poor households.

The replacement of households who exited from the program has already been institutionalized through the approved DSWD MC No. 12 Series of 2019, which allows the continuous replacement of CCT households to be covered by the program.

To cover the target shortfall for the 4.4M annual physical target, the National Program Management Office (NPMO) identified new poor households in the Listabanan 3 database as the new set of potential beneficiaries for replacement. Upon completion of the data quality checking and the Eligibility Check Routine (ECR) process for the replacement households and shall be registered under Set 12-A with a target of **73,598** as potential households subject for rigorous validation.

However, in order to successfully implement these activities, the DSWD XI would like to humbly request from your office thru your counterpart in the field to enjoin and support the necessary preparations in support of the Provincial/City/Municipal Operations with the following activities:
