We hope this letter finds you in good health. We are pleased to inform you that the National Crop Protection Center, College of Agriculture and Food Science, University of the Philippines Los Baños, in collaboration with the UP Professional School for Agriculture and the Environment (UP PSAE), AGRIYA, and PMCP Foundation Inc., is offering a short course titled "Butterfly Ranching and Commercial Breeding for Biodiversity Conservation and Livelihood."

The short course will be held in person at AGRIVA in Panabo City, Davao del Norte, from May 8 to 10, 2023. This 2.5-day short course is designed to engage the participants in butterfly biodiversity conservation and industry, specifically on butterfly farming and souvenir/curio making. The training will be a combination of lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on activities. The participants will learn biology, ecology, economic value, biodiversity conservation, and inventory of host plants and species of butterflies. The processes and requirements for butterfly mass production, captive breeding, and establishment of butterfly fatms will also be discussed thoroughly. They will also experience crafting souvenir products out of butterflies.

Upon completion of the course, participants are expected to be able to identify the different species of butterfly; identify the different host plants of butterflies and learn how to propagate them; discover the uses of butterflies and their by-products; acquire ideas and develop skills on how to make souvenirs from butterfly by-products; understand the processes of how to rear and mass produce butterflies and their host plants, including the establishment of a butterfly farm/garden; identify the legal requirements for butterfly collection and farming; and discuss how to establish a butterfly farm.

The registration fee is Php 5,000 per participant (inclusive of the individual kit: manual, starter host plants, breeder butterflies, insect net, butterfly spreader, some curation tools, 3R frame, lepidomosaic art pattern, snacks, and lunch for 2.5 days). Registration is now open until April 30, with limited slots available.
