- Each presenter is advised to prepare a Power point presentation, a copy of which should be submitted to the Policy Planning and Research Division on or before May 24, 2023.
- The powerpoint presentation should have a maximum of fifteen (15) slides, and the font size should be at least twenty-four (24). Findings should be presented in a clear and concise manner by utilizing tables, charts, graphs, and other visuals to illustrate the data.
- 3. Each presenter will be given fifteen (15) minutes to present their work, followed by a five-minute open forum for questions and discussion.
