The **Family Peace Association (FPA)** aims to build a world of peace and harmony through God-centered families. It is a movement of conscientious people coming from various faiths, culture, race, and ethnicity. The **Royal Institution of Singapore with Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA)** of Singapore under Registration No. 200307961C, is a recognized CPD Provider of the **Philippine Regulation Commission (PRC)** which aims to promote continuing professional development and recognize the importance of individual skills and education across all industries and professions.
