We are pleased to announce that the Family Peace Association (FPA) and the Royal Institution of Singapore are launching the First World Family Peace Leadership Convention on August 7-9, 2023, at the Manila Hotel, Philippines.

The Family Peace Association (FPA) aims to build a world of peace and harmony through Godcentered families. It is a movement of conscientious people coming from various faiths, culture, race, and ethnicity. The Royal Institution of Singapore with Accounting and Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA) of Singapore under Registration No. 200307961C, is a recognized CPD Provider of the Philippine Regulation Commission (PRC) which aims to promote continuing professional development and recognize the importance of individual skills and education across all industries and professions.

The theme of the convention is "The Essence of One Family Under God: A Platform of World Peace for a New Civilization". On the other hand, the August 7-9, 2023, F2F convention will have corresponding CPD credits units for professionals which will be provided by the Royal Institution of Singapore as a recognized CPD provider of PRC.
