Service credits shall be granted to the teacher-participants, proctors and TWG (DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003), while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) to supervisors and other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004) for the services rendered during Saturday and Sunday.

The school paper shall be submitted in **pdf format stored in 32G flash drive per Division** (top 5 winners) with the certificate of circulation duly signed by the principal and noted by Divisions-in-charge of journalism and approved by the Schools Division Superintendent, scaled on a short envelope on May 19, 2023, 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM at Durian Hall,3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, DepEd Regional Office XI

Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the DepEd Region XI adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. This Department reiterates its stand to disqualify school papers found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or electronic copy. The Division-in-charge of campus journalism shall be responsible for this aspect.

SDOs are enjoined to strictly follow the "No School Paper, No Student Contestant" in conducting the contest at the division level ensuring that all pupil/student participants have their respective published school paper.

The **top three winners** in all contest events per level per medium shall be recognized and the points garnered from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores following the guidelines. However, only the 1st Place winners in all events will represent the region in the 2023 NSPC.

Service credits shall be granted to the teacher participant (DepEd Order No. 53, s 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No.2, s 2004) for services rendered during weekend, and holidays.
