SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION IN THE 18th BSP NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

Date : June 7, 2023

In reference to Boy Scout of the Philippines (BSP) Council Office Memorandum No. 18, s. 2023 dated May 15, 2023, the field is informed that the Boy Scout of the Philippines – Davao del Sur Council will organize a contingent to the 18^{th} BSP NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE on December 11 - 17, 2023 at Passi City, Province of Iloilo.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES. The Camp aims to provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe, and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their full social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional and Spiritual potential as active citizens making real contributions in creating a better community.

QUALIFICATIONS. The following are the qualifications for the participation.

A SCOUT is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, must have parental consent and must be:

- Registered as a Boy Scout or Senior Scout with the Boy Scout of the Philippines;
- 9 years old and above but not over 19 years old;
- Equipped with camping gears;
- Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
- Fully vaccinated.

Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:

- Registered as an Adult Leader with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
- Trained as a Troop Leader. Asst. Troop Leader Outfit Advisor or Asst. Outfit Advisor;
- Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
- Fully vaccinated.

Registration Fee. A registration fee of TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (**Php. 12,000.00**) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee covers the Camp Fee (Php. 500.00), Contingent Souvenir (Php. 1,000.00), Food provision for ten days (Php. 3,000.00), transportation (Php. 7,000.00) and Camp Development (Php. 500.00).



Reservation Fee. A non-refundable but transferable Reservation Fee of **Php**. **2,000.00** must be paid to the council <u>on or before</u> **September 08, 2023**, Friday. And the deadline for the remaining balance of **Php**. **10,000.00** must be paid <u>on or before</u> **October 06, 2023**.

Transportation. The transportation of the participants shall be arranged and organized by the Local Council Office. Depending on the number of participants, the mode of transportation may either be by land or by air. Additional details regarding this shall be issued in a separate memorandum.

WHAT TO BRING: Participants are REQUIRED to bring the following camping items, to wit:

- Type "A" Scout uniform with black leather shoes;
- Sportswear and personal gears/beddings/tents;
- Eating utensils and toiletries;
- Medicine/First Aid Kit;
- Duly filled-up application form with parental consent and medical certificate.

Corresponding compensatory overtime and/or service credits shall be granted to all accompanying Adult Leaders as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.

Subject: 18th BSP NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE

- The Boy Scouts of the Philippines Davao del Sur Council is organizing a contingent to the 18th BSP NATIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE on December 11-17, 2023 at Passi City, Province of Iloilo.
- AIMS AND OBJECTIVE. The Camp aims to provide a progressive, exciting, challenging, safe, and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts in order to enhance their full Social, Physical, Intellectual, Character, Emotional and Spiritual potential as active citizens making real contributions in creating a better community.
- 3. **QUALIFICATIONS.** The following are the qualifications for participation.
 - 3.1. A Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, sufficient camping experience, must have parental consent and must be:
 - Registered as a Boy Scout or Senior Scout with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
 - 9 years old and above but not over 19 years old;
 - Equipped with camping gears;
 - · Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
 - Fully vaccinated.

3.2. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:

- · Registered as an Adult Leader with the Boy Scouts of the Philippines;
- Trained as a Troop Leader, Asst. Troop Leader Outfit Advisor or Asst. Outfit Advisor;
- Physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician; and
- Fully vaccinated.
- REGISTRATION FEE. A registration fee of TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (₱12,000.00) shall be collected from each participant. The registration fee covers the Camp Fee (₱500.00), Contingent Souvenir (₱1,000.00), Food provision for ten days (₱3,000.00), Transportation (₱7,000.00), and Camp Development (₱500.00).

RESERVATION FEE. A non-refundable but transferrable Reservation Fee of **P2,000.00** must be paid to the council <u>on or before</u> **September 08, 2023, Friday**.

The deadline for the remaining balance of **P10,000.00** must be paid on or before **October 06, 2023**.

5. **TRANSPORTATION**. The transportation of the participants shall be arranged and organized by the Local Council Office. Depending on the number of participants, the mode of transportation may either be by land or by air. Additional details regarding this shall be issued in a separate memorandum.

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3.2. Adult Leader must have the maturity and clarity about his role and must be:

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 - Duly filled-up application form with parental consent and medical certificate.
- 7. Corresponding compensatory overtime and/or service credits shall be granted to all accompanying Adult Leaders as provided for by DepEd Order No. 76, s. 2012.
- 8. For immediate information and widest dissemination to all concerned.
