Relative to Regional Memorandum CLMD-2023-220, the field is hereby informed of the conduct of Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), with the theme: "From Campus Journalism to Real-World Journalism: Shaping Minds from Schools to Societies" on June 8 -11, 2023 at Digos City.

A registration fee of Eight Hundred Pesos (Php 800) shall be charged to each participant including campus journalist, school paper, and coordinator, remitted in advance to the Davao Region Association of School Publication Adviser's, INC (DRASPA, INC) at LR office, Ground Floor Regional Office XI to defray expenses on certificates, medals, plaques, trophies, honorarium, Membership fees of One Hundred pesos (Php 100) for School Paper Advisers and Ninety Pesos (Php 90) for Campus Journalists shall be collected by the DRASPA treasurer, travel, meals and other related expenses, all are Maintenance and/or chargeable against School's other Operating Expenses/local/school/Special Education Fund, School Campus Journalist Fund and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Service credits shall be granted to the teacher-participants, proctors and TWG (DepEd Order No. 53 s. 2003), while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) to supervisors and other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2 s. 2004) for the services rendered during Saturday and Sunday.
