

VISA AND VACCINATION

All participants must enter Malaysia with Visa With Reference (VWR). Participants for the programme will receive a copy of the approval letter from IBFIM. Participant are required to obtain the VWR stamping from the nearest Malaysian Embassy/High Commission. Participants are required to be vaccinated for Covid-19 prior to arriving to Malaysia. Participants from countries listed in Appendix A are required to take a mandatory vaccination for Yellow Fever at least ten (10) days prior to their departure to Malaysia. Yellow Fever certificate is required upon landing in Malaysia.

All application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of their respective countries and should be submitted only through the diplomatic channel via Malaysian Embassy/High Commission of Malaysia, Successful candidates will be duly notified by IBFIM one (1) month before the commencement of the course, incomplete and/or unendorsed forms will not be considered.
