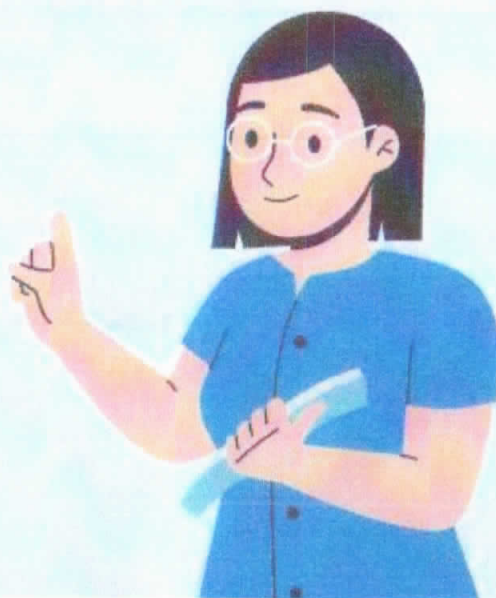

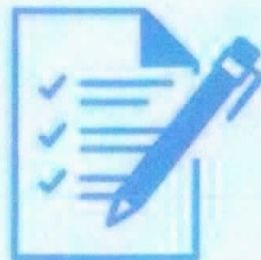

- Incoming or ongoing MA student in education specializing in STEM or Alternative Learning System, or TechVoc training.
- GWA of at least 2.0 or above or its equivalent from the previous semester or academic year.
- At least 1 year teaching experience in either public or private school with the intent to teach as a K-12 public school teacher of Science or Math (or any STEM-related subject) OR a tertiary level instructor/professor of any STEM-related subject or course.
- No failed, incomplete, or dropped grades from the previous semester.
- Must be of good moral standing with no existing disciplinary case at the university he/she enrolled in and at the public school he/she is teaching.
- Must have at least a "Satisfactory" rating in teaching performance from the previous year.
- In need of financial support to complete his/her studies.
- Preferably not a recipient of any other scholarships.
- Must be in good health.

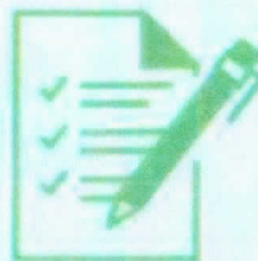

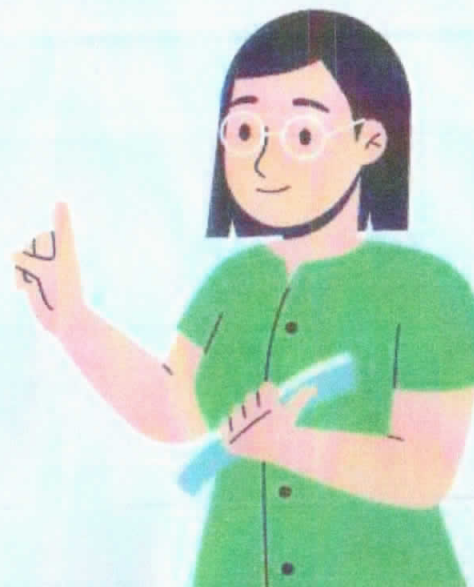
