Further, no government funds shall be used for this purpose.



The Camp aims to

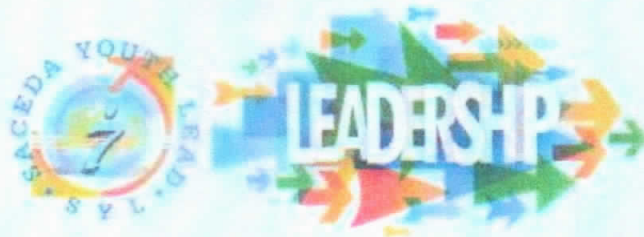
1. define what is leadership and leadership development;
