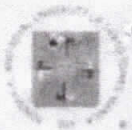


The learning investment is Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000) inclusive of four snacks and two lunch, learning materials and Certificates.






