Visayas (Boracay Tropical Resorts, Boracay) on August 10-11, 2023

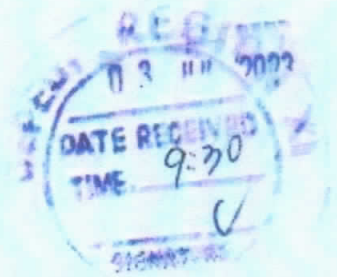
Mindanao (University of Southern Mindanao, Cotabato) on September 28-29, 2023
