






DATE : April 24, 2023

The Operations Strand, through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), in partnership with Food Safety and Hygiene Academy of the Philippines (FoodSHAP), will conduct the **Training on Basic Food Safety (BFS), Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP), and Food Safety Compliance Officer (FSCO)**. The activities aim to:

- a. Train and certify select DepEd Health Personnel/program focal persons as experts in BFS, HACCP and as FSCO to ensure adherence to the food safety standards and compliance with the law; and
- b. Update the database/directory of DepEd certified FSCOs.



1. This has reference to **OUOPS Memo No. 2023-03-4154** re: *Training on Basic Food Safety (BFS), Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Point (HACCP), and Food Safety Compliance Officer (FSCO)*.
2. The venue for Training on BFS and HACCP – Batch 2 will be held at **Harolds Evotel, Cebu City** on **August 7-11, 2023**.
3. Please be informed and reminded on the following:
 - a. Batch 2 participants are **Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and BARMM**.
 - b. Participants are expected to arrive at 12:00 noon of August 7, 2023, and may proceed in the designated Conference Hall upon arrival at the venue. The opening program will begin at **2:00 pm**.
 - c. The hotel will accommodate participants for check-in at 2:00 pm. The first meal to be served is **Lunch**.
 - d. It is advised that attendees shall bring their own **laptops, extension cords, internet back-up, alcohol pads, apron, hairnet, disposable gloves, and facemask**.
 - e. Batch 2 participants shall accomplish the **pre-registration form on or before August 3, 2023** accessible at: bit.ly/DEPED_REG2.
 - f. **BFS and HACCP trainings are intensive and require participants' concentration and focus during technical sessions/discussions**.
 - g. Post-test will be administered at the end of every course (multiple choice and practical exam). Participants must pass all assessments to receive the certificates to be posted within 15 to 20 working days after the date of examination.

- h. The traveling expenses of the participants **will be charged against local funds** subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participants who have attended the BFS and HACCP **are required** to attend the FSCO training as **prerequisites** for the Food Safety Compliance Officer certification. **NO REPLACEMENT IS ALLOWED.**
 5. Participants who are experiencing any Covid-19 related symptoms or tested positive for Covid-19 antigen or RT-PCR are discouraged from attending the training. Vaccination card shall be readily available and be presented to authorities upon arrival at Cebu City as needed.
