



Abstract Submission

The study Abstract must be submitted on or before October 30, 2023 (Monday). Interested presenters must email their entries with this Subject: IRCon2023 Entry-Paper Presenter-Surname (e.g. IRCon2023 Entry-Paper Presenter-Reyes) to research@jmc.edu.ph. Accepted abstracts will receive a Notice of Acceptance. Only one presenter per paper is allowed during the Oral Presentation.

- a. The abstract should include the following:
 - i. Research Title
 - ii. Name of Researcher/affiliation, email address-
 - iii. IMRAD format in not more than 250 words
 - iv. Five (5) Keywords (minimum)
 - v. References in APA format
- b. Use the typeface font of 12-point Arial, Word Document format, single-spaced.
- c. Email the abstract to: research@imc.edu.ph on or before October 30, 2023.
- d. Accepted abstract will receive a Notice of Acceptance.

The following are the suggested contents of PowerPoint:

1. INTRODUCTION

The INTRODUCTION should contain:

- » Situational analysis of the problem
- » Gap in the literature from the literature reviews that the study intends to find.
- » Differentness of the study from other previous studies.
- » Relevance of the study.

2. RESEARCH QUESTIONS/OBJECTIVES

» Specify the aims of the research

3. FRAMEWORK (if applicable)

- » It should contain a basic explication of the meaning of the variables of the study.
- » Present the framework in either schematic or textual form merging the theories discussed in which the study was anchored.
- » Provide a diagram if necessary.
- » No diagram is required for qualitative studies

4. METHODOLOGY

- » Research Design
- » Research Participants and Sampling
- » Instrumentation

Reliability and Validity

» Data Analysis

Note: Methods may vary for Information technology, Business, and Engineering Disciplines (Non-IMRAD formats)

5. RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

- » Summary tables and significant results, graphs, charts
- » Long tables with brimming data should be avoided

6. CONCLUSIONS/IMPLICATIONS

» Highlight new discovery (if any) that you obtained only after completing the study, something (not found in the literature) which contributes to new knowledge. » This section supports or negates previous conclusions, validates the theory used, and/or generates new theory.

Paper Presentation Mechanics & Criteria

- 1. Presenters must log in to the Zoom link 30 mins before the scheduled presentation.
- 2. Presenters are required to be in their presentation attire (may opt for casual or business attire) and must use the IRCON 2023 virtual background.
- Presenters must orally deliver the study with an aid of a multimedia facility (preferably a maximum of 12 slides in PowerPoint format).
- 4. Presentation shall be LIVE however, a recorded presentation shall be allowed in the event of an internet connection problem. Participants therefore must prepare a recorded presentation.
- Each presenter will be given 10 minutes to present. After every four (4) presenters, the judge shall ask questions and/or give their reactions to the papers presented.
- The judge will no longer ask questions on the content of the paper but may ask questions only to see the skills on presentation.
- Best Presenter shall be chosen per breakout room.
- 8. Winners will be awarded a Certificate of Recognition.
- 9. Participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- The certificate will be issued and sent within 10 working days following the event.
- 11. The decision of the judge is deemed final and irrevocable.

Scoring Criteria: The paper presentations are scored based on the following criteria:

Research content and design	30%	
Ability to answer questions and capture audiences' attention	20%	
Ability to convey the research findings (compelling call for action)	20%
