The Department of Education Regional Office XI, through the Education Support Services Division ensures the safe and sound mental health of the school populace especially while they are in school as much as possible. However, with the growing threats, stressors, and illegal substances present in the environment and with the advent of social media, it is inevitable that one's good and sound mind will be destroyed in terms of judgment and ability to handle emotions.

For the first quarter of 2023, a total of eight completed suicide cases and thirty-two attempted suicide cases were recorded in the School-Based Adolescent-Friendly Health Facilities and both were inflicted by learners themselves.

With these increasing cases of suicide, this Office requests funding and technical support from the Department of Health - Davao Center for Health Development for the conduct of the **Training on MhGAP**, which aims at scaling up services for mental, neurological, and substance use disorders. The program asserts that with proper care, psychosocial assistance, and medication, tens of millions could be treated for depression, schizophrenia, and epilepsy, which will be prevented from suicide, and can begin to lead normal lives - even when resources are scarce.

The activity will be conducted on **September 4-6, 2023**, at the **Grand Regal Hotel**, J.P. Laurel Avenue, Lanang, Davao City. This is to be participated by all SDO - Mental Health Coordinators, Alternate Focal Persons, and Medical Officers (**Annex A**).

Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
