15.	AM - Policy Action and Strategic Planning (PASP)
	Strategic planning is a disciplined effort that produces fundamental decisions and actions that shape and guide what an educational organization is, who it serves, what it does, and why it does it, with a focus on the future. Effective strategic planning articulates not only where the educational organization is going and the actions needed to make progress, but also how it will know if it is successful.
Day 1	PM - Curriculum, Instruction and Management (CIM)
	Curriculum defines what is taught, instruction determines how it is taught, and management ensures effective implementation of educational policies and practices. These three interrelated components form the foundation of the educational system, encompassing the key elements necessary for effective teaching and learning. Educational leaders have a multifaceted role in overseeing these components within their districts to improve educational outcomes, provide support to schools and teachers, and foster a conducive learning environment for all students.
	AM - Research and Evaluation (RE)
Day 2	Research and evaluation in the school setting is an important aspect of effective leadership in schools. Good leaders make decisions based on empirical data such as instructional designs for students' progress in learning, motivating teachers' performance and instruction, and overall management of the teaching force. The domain tackles the different aspects of the research cycle, different research designs, methods, approaches, and data analysis.
	PM - Educational Leadership and Management (ELM)
	This domain covers the different theories and models of leadership and management. The theories and models are presented by looking at its overview, characteristics of a leader, empirical basis, its components, and some examples.
Day 3	AM - Integration (Essay) The integration session provides the participants with vignettes describing a situation a superintendent might commonly encounter and be required to







respond to. The vignette is followed by a focused question that asks what the superintendent might do next, what factors the superintendent should consider in responding to the situation, how the superintendent might handle the situation or dilemma presented, or what the potential consequences of action are in the situation. The candidate is required to answer the question with specific details and to give a rationale for the answer when appropriate. This category includes vignettes that deal with situations drawn from such content areas as group processes, facilitation of student learning, and organizational resources and operations, as well as other content areas identified in their job scope.

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
