In alignment with the ongoing commitment to advance gender and equality and inclusivity, this Office directs Schools Division Offices (SDOs) to establish a Gender and Development (GAD) Corner on the official website.

The 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State recognizes the role of women in nation building and shall ensure the fundamental equality before the law of women and men. The Women in Development and Nation Building Act or R.A. No. 7192, enacted in 1992, reiterates the principle of gender equality and directs all government agencies to "review and revise all their regulations to remove gender bias therein."(Section 2).

In reference to DepEd Order 32, s., 2017 known as Gender-Responsive Basic Education Policy commits to integrate the principles of gender equality, gender equity, gender sensitivity, non-discrimination and human rights, in the provision and governance of basic education.

The GAD Corner's primary goal is to provide a focal point for promoting awareness, understanding, and integration of gender perspectives in all policies, programs, and projects.

This initiative is also an instrument to uphold the rights and welfare of all genders and to create a conducive environment for all gender equality and women empowerment.

The following are the responsibilities of the GAD Corner Focal:

1. Information Dissemination: Provide up-to-date information and resources regarding gender policies, laws, and regulations.

2. Awareness Building: Conduct and coordinate seminars, webinars, and workshops to create awareness and educate employees and stakeholders about gender and development issue.
3. Policy Development: Facilitate the integration of gender perspectives into local policies, programs, and projects in line with the GAD Plan and Budget (GPB) guidelines.
4. Monitoring and Evaluation: Regularly monitor and evaluate the effectiveness and impact of the GAD efforts implemented in the SDO.

Each SDO should identify a responsible person or team to manage the GAD Corner to ensure transparency, quality, and effectiveness.
