Subject : REITERATION OF AND ADDENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM 205, S.2018 (GUIDELINES FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS RECEIVING GOVERNMENT SUBSIDY)

Date : September 18, 2023

Pursuant to the enclosed Regional Memorandum (RM) 20, s.2023 and the abovementioned RM, this Office informs/reminds all Private Learning Institutions/private schools **receiving government subsidy** thru the **Education Service Contracting (ESC), Teachers' Salary Subsidy (TSS) and Senior High School (SHS) Voucher Program** of the following:

- a) to inform their parent stakeholders that the government is the funding source of ESC, TSS and the SHS Voucher Program;
- b) to post a tarpaulin to ensure that the students, teachers and the public are aware that the school is receiving government subsidy; and
- c) to post the official list of the student-beneficiaries/recipients of any or all of the programs in their respective official website and school bulletin board.

Relative to this, all participating private schools are required to conduct/implement the following activities:

Uy) for QA and endorsement to QAD, ROXI on Oct. 27, 2023.
	 For SY 2024- 2025 & Onwards: The conduct of the orientation shall be within the 1st month of the SY 	 Submission of report shall be 15 days after the conduct of the activity. The report shall serve as additional bases for RO XI in processing payments for the school beneficiaries.

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 Posting of a Tarpaulin re. School Receiving Government Subsidy, with the following text: This school, <u>name of</u> <u>school</u>, with office address at is receiving financial subsidy for the Educational Service Contracting, Teachers' Salary Subsidy and Senior High School Voucher Program from the Government through the Department of Education. 	> ASAP	The tarpaulin shall measure 3 feet in width and 5 feet in length, to be posted at the gate or front fence. If the school is a recipient of the SHS voucher program only, then the ESC and the TSS shall be excluded from the text, and vice versa.
3. Posting of the official list of the student- beneficiaries/ recipients every SY	> ASAP	To be posted at the school's official website and bulletin board.

Provisions not mentioned in this Division Memorandum but are stipulated in the enclosed RM 205, S.2018 remain in effect.


