CONTEST GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA OF YELLS AND CHEERS

Mechanics:

1. The competition shall be participated by District.
Each district should have one entry.

1. Mt. Apo
2. Digos Oriental
3. Digos Occidental
4. Digos South
5. Secondary Schools

2. The overall perform should last for 3 minutes. Beyond this limit, a total of 1 point will be deducted from the consolidated total score. The performance will be done on the assigned place/seats.
3. The use of Vulgar Language is prohibited and will be subject to disqualification.
4. The use of body movements, lifts, and tossing are allowed provided that it will not endanger anyone.
5. The use of drums and other instruments is allowed. Note: The yell must be audible, and not be overpowered by the sounds produced by the instruments.
6. The use of props is allowed, provided that it will not hinder the next performers. Performers then are expected to clear the performance area after their respective performances.
7. Criteria for judging are the following:

CRITERIA	Percentage
Performance delivery (mastery and synchronization, projection and confidence, team spirit and unity)	50%
Entertainment (Variations of formation, creativity, props and sound accompaniment)	20%
Audibility and Volume (clarity of yells)	30%
TOTAL	100%

8. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
