- E. Entries must be in A4 size and JPEG or PNG file format.
- F. Entries must be registered and submitted on or before October 15, 2023 via https://bit.ly/2023-R11-NSM
- G. Digital posters will be rated according to the following criteria:

Originality	30% 30%
