The College Prep Program (CPP) application season is now OPEN for 11th graders. We hope your office can ensure that schools in your district can post the attached flyer and disseminate the news to 11th graders. Let me tell you more about this unique mentorship program for high-performing students interested in applying to universities and colleges in the United States.

The program mentors and guides highly qualified Filipino high school 11th graders committed to applying to colleges and universities in the United States. The CPP is tailored toward students who are likely to be awarded financial aid from U.S. colleges and universities but need more financial resources to cover upfront costs. The program provides mentorship, coaching, college prep assistance, and general skill development to succeed in college. Activities include SAT and ACT preparation and practice tests, TOEFL and English language test prep, coaching sessions on essay writing, college applications, researching colleges and scholarships, and other college preparation advising. Participants will be helped with the upfront costs, such as test prep materials and application fees. Those attending school in the U.S. will be given a stipend to help with upfront costs such as visa fees and plane tickets (tuition is not covered). Students with excellent grades, extracurriculars, leadership potential, and interest in attending college in the U.S. are invited to apply for this 18-month program. To apply, students must be 11th graders in high school, have an excellent academic transcript, and have a verifiable family income of below PHP 1.25 million.
