Mechanics:

 The competition shall be participated by District. Each district should have one entry.

1.	Mt. Apo
2.	Digos Oriental
3.	Digos Occidental
4.	Digos South
5.	Secondary Schools

- 2. The overall perform should last for 3 minutes. Beyond this limit, a total of 1 point will be deducted from the consolidated total score. The performance will be done on the assigned place/seats.
- The use of Vulgar Language is prohibited and will be subject to disqualification.
- 4. The use of body movements, lifts, and tossing are allowed provided that it will not endanger anyone.
- The use of drums and other instruments is allowed. Note: The yell must be audible, and not be overpowered by the sounds produced by the instruments.
- The use of props is allowed, provided that it will not hinder the next performers. Performers then are expected to clear the performance area after their respective performances.
- 7. Criteria for judging are the following:

CRITERIA	Percentage
Performance delivery (mastery and synchronization, projection and confidence, team spirit and unity)	50%
Entertainment (Variations of formation, creativity, props and sound accompaniment)	20%
Audibility and Volume (clarity of yells)	30%
TOTAL	100%
