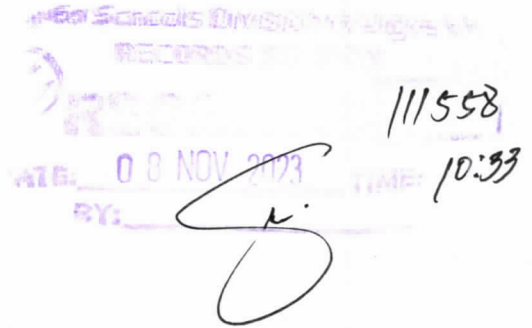

5. The winning entry shall become the property of the Digos City Library and will be used as the Official Logo of our City Library.
6. The brief summary/meaning of the design shall be included in the entry.
7. All entries should be submitted in digital format (JPEG, PNG) and must be sent to digoscitylibrary@gmail.com on or before November 20, 2023.
8. Awarding cash prizes and certificate of recognition is on November 29, 2023

1. The entry is solo storytelling. One participant per public or private secondary schools.
2. The participant may choose her own piece of short story telling
3. Use of school uniform, costume, and make-up are not allowed.

Boys and Girls – white t-shirt or polo and pants of any color

4. Human sound effects, background, or props are allowed to support the story.
5. The story must be delivered from memory and any movement is confined onstage.
