In line with this, the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations (OUOPS), through the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Operations (OASOPS) and Bureau of Learner Support Services – Learner Formation Division (BLSS-LFD), transitioning from *Youth Formation Division*, will spearhead the conduct of the **2023 National Students' Day Celebration on November 17, 2023 (Friday)** at the **Hotel de Crisbelle, Digos City, Davao del Sur**. 
