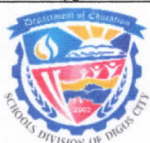

Subject: IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (MODE) IN EARTHQUAKE-AFFECTED PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS

Date : December 4, 2023

Relative to the recent strong earthquakes and several aftershocks that confronted Davao Region and nearby provinces, and the issuances of the different Local Government Units declaring suspension of classes and adoption of Work-From-Home arrangement, this Office highly encourages Education Program Supervisors in Alternative Delivery Mode and in the different learning areas, to ensure the availability of the different Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) within the period covered by the declaration of class suspension and other emergencies. The School Heads are also advised to intensify the activation of the ADM One-Stop-Shop to appropriately address the different needs and contexts of the learners in the affected areas.

The blended learning delivery modality and other available learning delivery modalities shall be utilized and the Self-Learning Modules (SLMs) which are aligned to the Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs) and are approved and considered final by DepEd Central Office, shall be used by the schools as the primary learning resources for ADM EiE implementation.

This aims to promote the implementation of ADM Education in Emergencies (ADM EIE) to ensure continuity of learning during calamities and other challenging situations

The ADM Supervisors are advised to conduct online monitoring and evaluation to ensure the proper implementation, and to submit a report to the Regional ADM Supervisor through <https://tinyurl.com/ROXIADMEiE>, on the status of implementation within the period of emergency.
