

## Girl Scout Greetings!

We are grateful for the 36 participants who availed the Japan Cherry Biossom Experience on April 5-9, 2024.

After another follow-up discussion with our partner agency, we are glad to inform you the following updates:

- 1. "GUARANTEED SINGLE ENTRY VISA" has been granted to the group.
- 2. GSP Eastern Mindanao will serve as sponsoring organization. The office bank account will be used in the application of all participants.

VISA requirements are trimmed down. Have your own check list and follow the guidelines to refrain from disapproval of VISA.

- 3.1 PHILIPPINE PASSPORT
  - Broken Passport is not accepted
  - Passport must be signed and must have at least two (2) blank pages
  - Passport should have at least 6 months validity from the date of travel
- 3.2 1 pc PASSPORT SIZE COLORED PHOTO ON WHITE BACKGROUND
  - Photo must be recent, 4.5mm x 3.5mm
  - Not blurred, no accessories, no showing of teeth
- 3.3 PSA BIRTH CERTIFICATE (Issued within 12 months)
  - If late registration: Baptismal Certificate and form 137 from Elementary/High School or Explanation Letter
  - If unreadable: Birth Certificate from Local Civil Registry
  - If NO record in PSA: Birth Certificate Issued by Local Civil Registrar and Negative Certificate issued by PSA

## 3.4 PSA MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE/CONTRACT (issued within 12 months)-if married

- If unreadable: Marriage Certificate from Local Civil Registry
- If NO record in PSA: Marriage Certificate Issued by Local Civil Registrar and Negative Certificate issued by PSA

# 3.5 VISA APPLICATION FORM provided by partner agency

- No erasures, no blank item. If not applicable, fill in N/A
- Must be printed to an A4 size bond paper. Just fill in the personal details, partner agency will fill in the rest of the information.

- 3.6 AUTHORIZATION LETTER provided by partner agency
  Only signature above printed name
  - If there is a used Japanese visa in the passport, PSA Birth Certificate and Marriage Certificate are unnecessary
- Cebu Pacific approved another 20 slots on the same rate.
  Deadline of additional participants will be on November 15, 2023 (first payment, first serve) basis.

Please be reminded of our payment schedule. Downpayment is NOT REFUNDABLE but TRANSFERRABLE (if VISA is not yet processed and airline is not yet paid).

November 15, 2023-Php10,000.00 (required 2<sup>nd</sup> payment)December 15, 2023-Php10,000.00January 15, 2024-Php10,000.00February 15, 2024-remaining balance\*Participants may opt to pay in full anytime before the payment schedule.
