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Participating teachers shall observe the time-on-task policy based on **DepEd No. 9, s. 2005** titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith to ensure that learning shall not be disrupted and continued for the benefit of the learners*. Additionally, their participation shall adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024, titled *Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024)* and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject *Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities*.

The qualified teachers are likewise eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 titled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers*.
