In support of the Department of Education's commitment to providing accessible and quality education through the MATATAG four-point agenda, particularly on the provision of quality and accessible education to all, including those who are disadvantaged and at risk of dropping out, the Department of Education Regional Office XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the Regional Orientation/Workshop on Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) and Updates for Public Schools District Supervisors on June 18-19, 2024, at the Sunny Point Hotel, Mag, Davao City.
