- 3) FSP-Indigenous Cultural Communities/Indigenous Peoples (ICCs/IPs) - intended for ALS/SH/SHS graduates/graduating students whose parent/s or legal guardian/s are members of a particular ICCs & IPs recognized by the National Commission on Indigenous Peoples (NCIP).

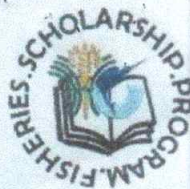

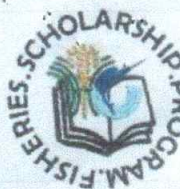

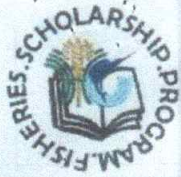
