Reports shall be the basis of schools for intervention using the available materials from Central Office or SDO/School Intervention initiatives. Regional and Schools Division Offices shall conduct monitoring as to the effectiveness of the intervention so appropriate technical assistance will be provided.

Enclosure 3. Flowchart of CRLA Administration










