As part of the celebration of our 50th Founding Anniversary, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines – Davao del Sur Council is pleased to announce the conduct of the 1st COUNCIL KID & KAB PALARO on 05-06 October 2024 at Don Mariano Marcos Elementary School Grounds, Plaridel St., Digos City, Davao del Sur with the Theme: "Sustaining Growth".

- 2. **Objectives.** The activity aims to provide a progressive, safe, and enjoyable learning environment for the Scouts, to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional, and spiritual potential.
- 3. **Qualification for Participation**. The following are the qualifications for all participating Scouts and Adult Leaders:

a. Scouts

- 1. Must be currently registered as KID Scout or KAB Scout with a Langkay or Kawan;
- 2. Physically fit to undergo strenuous activities as certified by a Licensed Physician;
- 3. Must be at least four (4) to nine (6) years old for KID Scouts:
- 4. Must be at least six (6) to nine (9) years old for KAB Scouts; and
- 5. Must secure his Parental/Guardian's Consent.

b. Unit Leader

- Must be of good moral character;
- 2. Must be currently registered as Langkay or Kawan Leader:
- 3. Must be physically fit as certified by a Licensed Physician;
- 4. Preferably a graduate of the Basic Training Course for Unit Leaders;
- 4. **Registration Details.** Stated below are the important details regarding the Jamboree Registration System and Procedure, viz:
 - a. Registration Fee. An amount of TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) shall be charged from each participant in order to defray administrative costs, program materials, souvenir, and other operating expenses.
 - b. Deadline. The non-refundable but transferrable Registration Fee of ₱200.00 must be paid to the Local Council on or before Friday, September 27, 2024.

To avoid any logistical issues and challenges in the planning and preparations of the activity, the REGISTRATION FEE will DETERMINE the ACTUAL Number of Participants of each School or District. The Local Council will NOT be accepting any ON-SITE Registration.

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- Participation Quota. To exercise effective and efficient unit organization and management, a ratio of One

 Adult Leader for every Eight (8) KID or KAB Scouts (1:8) must be observed in the composition of the Palaro Contingent.
- Palaro Staff / Local Service Team (LST). Supporting the implementation of the different activities
 throughout the duration of the Palaro is the LST. It is composed of highly trained, motivated, and committed
 Volunteers and Adult Leaders assigned to the different activities, catering to both the program needs and
 administration requirements.
- 7. **Food Provision.** Each District or School must provide for their own food and other basic requirements that will be sufficient throughout the entire duration of the Palaro.
- 8. Arrival. All participants are advised to report at the Palaro Site not later than 8:00 AM of Saturday, 05 October 2024.
- 9. All concerned are hereby enjoined to promote and help ensure the maximum participation of the Scouts and Adult Leaders within your respective Areas and Districts. You are further advised to organize working committees in order to support your respective delegations to ensure the efficient preparation for the events and the smooth relay of information and other details.
