 - Is a non-smoker
 - Has no comorbidities such as hypertension, diabetes, and other diseases
- b. No fever, cough, and colds
- c. Well-rested with at least 8 hours of sleep before the conduct of the activity
- d. With a weight of at least 50 kg or 110 lbs
- e. With regular rhythm, 60-100 beats/min.
- f. Has normal blood pressure: 90-160 mmHg systolic and 60-100 mmHg diastolic

Transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged to local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
