DepEd National Employees Union (DepED NEU) – Digos City Chapter will conduct BASKOG 2024: DepED NEUlympics with this year's theme "Innovate, Dominate, Inspire". This theme fosters a culture of continuous learning, resilience, and emotional connection, driving teams to achieve extraordinary results and leaving a lasting, positive impact on everyone involved. This activity also aims to promote wellness outside of day-to-day work to help employees to stay focused and work better together through sports and recreation activities, allow employees to step out of their comfort zone and get to know colleagues from other departments, and showcase their capabilities and cultivate the spirit of camaraderie with other personnel.

All NEU members, School Heads, and non-teaching personnel are encouraged to actively participate in the scheduled activities or provide moral and logistical support to their designated teams. Please refer to attached list of participants per group.

The participants for the events are grouped into four (4) teams, namely, **Red Dragons**, **Blue Eagles**, **Green Gators and Orange Lions**. Each team shall prepare its respective yells and cheers of not more than one minute. T-shirt for each member of the group costs P200.00 charged to his/her personal funds.

The following are the ball games to be played during the activity, to wit: Basketball Male, Volleyball Male, and Volleyball Female. Other competitions outlined are Solo and Duet Singing, Ballroom Dance, e-Sports (Mobile Legend), Scrabble, Word Factory, Snakes and Ladder and Teambuilding Games (Amazing Race).

Elimination rounds for the ball games will be conducted at DICNHS Covered Court. (See schedule of activities). Venue for the championship games will be played at Dawis Elementary School for the volleyball (male/female).

Participants to the Ballroom Dance are allowed to conduct their practice every Fridays of September 2024 with additional sessions on weekends if necessary. Each team is provided with choreographers, to assist during the practice. Participants are requested to coordinate with them. A separate memorandum will be prepared to this effect.

Moreover, there will be an Election of Officers to be conducted at around 11:00AM in the morning of the culmination day. The Division NEU Officers shall appoint Election Committee that shall compose of a Chairman and two members. The committee shall be responsible for the peaceful and orderly conduct of the election and shall proclaim the elected officers. The same shall automatically be dissolved 3 days after the duly elected officers are proclaimed. Oathtaking and turnover ceremonies will then follow in the afternoon after the Election Committee has officially declared the elected officers.

All school heads of sections/offices and school heads shall assign staff/personnel (frontline services providers) to cater to transacting clients to ensure that their needs are properly acted, and usual operations of the office shall not be disrupted. In view of this, all non-teaching personnel are also advised to accomplish their weekly assigned tasks within Mondays to Thursdays.

School Heads are requested to do necessary arrangement in cases where teachers leave their classrooms to perform requested functions relevant to this activity. Personnel participating in the ballroom dance competition, choreographers, tournament managers and technical officials are entitled to service credits for teachers, while compensatory time off for non-teaching personnel, for the services rendered on Saturday and Sunday per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, when necessary.

Travel and other incidental expenses to the attendance shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Enclosed are the schedule of activities, lists of groups/teams, mechanics for the different competitions with criteria for judging, and list of technical working groups for the event. Division Health and Nutrition Unit shall act as Medic-on-Duty to attend to medical needs of participants.

MECHANICS OF THE COMPETITION

Event: Ballroom Dance Competition Mechanics:

- 1. Each Group/Team will perform a dance number minimum of 3 minutes but not more than 4 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 1 point will be deducted from the consolidated total score.
- 2. Each group will have minimum of 10 and maximum of 12 members.
- 5. The members of the groups may be composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
- 6. The dance number must have an accompaniment of any standard ballroom music.
- 7. The use of pyrotechnic gadgets, a smoke or combustible material as props is not allowed.
- 8. The criteria for judging are the following:

CRITERIA Choreography (Creativity, Artistry and Style)	
Costume and Music (Standard Ballroom)	20%
TOTAL	100%

Event: Solo Singing Competition Mechanics:

- 1. Each team must select one representative in the said contest.
- 2. The song could be English or Tagalog at the option of the participant.
- 3. Criteria for judging are the following:

Timing and Diction (Rhythm, Harmony, Clarity of Words)	30%
Expression and interpretation (Showmanship, Choice of Music)	20%
