

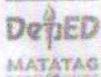

The proposed National Congress for Technical Vocational Education and Training aims to achieve the following objectives:


- a. Enhance the Quality of TVET by providing comprehensive training for Technical-Vocational teachers, and program implementers.
